

## **Child Rights Associate (CRA), Aspirational Districts Program (ADP) and Aspirational Blocks program (ABP)**

### **Position Overview**

The CRA shall be responsible for facilitating support to the District Administration, ensuring coordination and convergence among various departments in the assigned districts and blocks.

### **Roles and Responsibilities**

**CRA shall be responsible for Assisting District Administration in the following :**

- Conducting vulnerability mapping and linking vulnerable children / families with social welfare schemes of the central and state government.
- Effective functioning of systems/institutions in place.
- Protection and rehabilitation of children from various forms of exploitation such as child marriage , child trafficking, child labour, CSA etc .
- Organizing capacity building workshops for stakeholders responsible for child protection.
- Conducting awareness workshops in the district / blocks on child rights.
- Ensuring effective coordination and convergence among departments working on child rights.
- Tracking real-time progress on ADP indicators such as, health & nutrition, education, and child protection.

- 2-5 years of relevant experience.

- Committed to the cause of working with children.
- Good communication and networking skills
- Strong organizational and multitasking skills.
